1. Contact us on or after Feb. 16 at 8 am to be a Consignor, Helper, and/or Vendor:

- **Consignors:** EMAIL info@foreveryseason.net your entire availability for drop off days/times **and** if you wish to be a helper in addition to consigning **on or after Feb. 16 8:00 am.** Space is limited!! Registrations are taken in the order in which they are received and therefore, emails received before 8am on Open Registration day will be disregarded in an effort of fairness.
- **Helpers only:** EMAIL lori@foreveryseason.net or CALL 803-327-5473 to schedule your helper shift. Shifts are available March 10-22. You may elect to work 3 or 6 hours.
- **Vendors:** EMAIL lisa@foreveryseason.net for Vendor information. Vendor space is limited and offered on a first come, first serve basis.

2. Prepare your consignment items and price tags

for 60% of the sale price. Select only those items in gently used condition, **and those NOT on the Consumer Product Safety Commission's list of recalls.** You should verify that by visiting www.cpsc.gov or calling 1-800-638-2772.

3. Choose your preferred tag method

a. **For Every Season's Consign Design Tags:** This program (free to you), designed especially for For Every Season consignors, offers a user-friendly system that converts your information into our tag requirements with one click of a button. Simply contact us for our username and password, and then follow all the complete downloading instructions from our website: On our homepage, select the "Consignment" heading; then select "Tagging instructions" for the *Consign Design* tags!

b. **Computer generated tags:** If you would like to complete your price tags using your computer without a download, simply use our tag template. Visit our website at www.foreveryseason.net, then choose "consignment heading," and finally click the option "Tagging instructions." You will see this option for tagging your items.

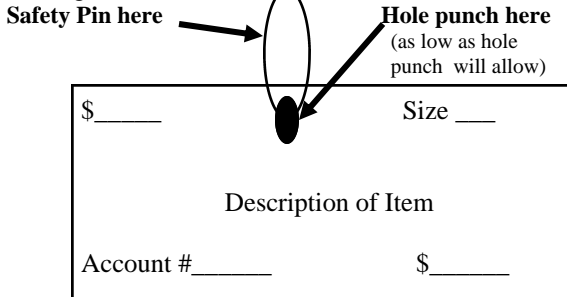
c. **Handwritten Tags:** Please use a 3 x 5 white index card with the price, consignor account #, and numerical size written in ink. Write the entire tag in blue or black ink for items to be reduced at the 50% Markdown Sale and red ink for items to remain at full price.

These requirements apply to each method:

- Prices should be on the dollar or half dollar (\$5.00 or \$5.50) and all sizes should be numerical. (Use only S, M, L, XL for maternity.)
- Tags should be on 64 lb or heavier weighted card stock /index cards
- Items remaining full priced must be in RED ink

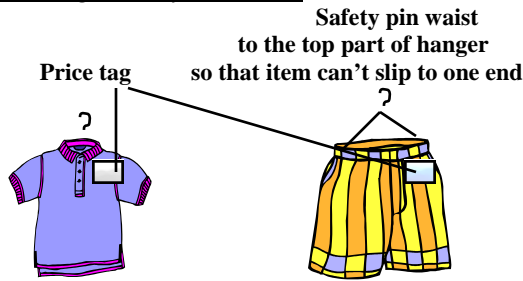
- For security reasons, we do not accept incorrect size, placement, altered tags (scratched out, wite-out, labels, etc.) or any other incorrectly prepared price tags. Please visit the website for more details, or ask us if unsure!!

- All three methods should produce identical looking tags:



- Hole-punch a hole in the center of the top of the price tag. Safety pin the price tag vertically (up & down) through that center hole to the garment as shown. (No straight pins accepted.)

Attach tags exactly as shown:



Apparel/Clothing: Spring & Summer clothing should be freshly cleaned, ironed, and on hangers, with the open end facing left (as shown above.) Two-piece outfits should be labeled "2-pc." on one price tag and have the garments fastened together with safety pins waist to shoulders, back-to-back, on one hanger. Clothing items include playwear, dress clothes, swimwear, raingear, sportswear, sleepwear, school uniforms, scouting/karate uniforms, etc.



Shoes: Tie shoes together using string and attach price tag to shoes with a string tied through the buckle or loop of shoes. Shoes include athletic and dress shoes, swim shoes, cleats, dance, bedroom shoes, rain boots, etc.

Accessories: Items such as hair bows, neck & bow ties, belts, tights, socks, caps, etc., should be placed in a sealed plastic bag if sold in sets. Place price tag in the inside of the plastic bag where it can be seen. Please do not staple tag.



Books, DVD's, & Electronics: Items must be clean and in good working condition. Attach price tag by string or safety pin if possible. (Use tape only if necessary.) Books may be placed in bags with price tag on the inside of bag or tied together with string (like a package) with price tag tied to front. Electronic equipment must be up-to-date and includes Game Cube, PS2, XBOX, Wii, handheld games, TV plug-ins, etc. We do not accept VCR or cassette tapes, computers, TVs, etc. at this sale.

Outdoor & Indoor Toys: Items include swimming pools, sandboxes, playhouses, kitchen sets, bikes, ride-on toys, books, puzzles, games, art sets, sporting equipment, skates, safety equipment, etc. Only battery-operated or licensed character (ex. Clifford, Arthur, etc.) stuffed animals will be accepted. Battery-operated toys/equipment must have working batteries in them. Tie (not tape, if possible) tag to item.

Baby Equipment/Furniture: Items include cribs, bassinets, changing tables, rockers, gliders, high chairs, strollers, swings, bouncy seats, lamps, bedding, car seats, etc. Tie (not tape, if possible) tag to item.

4. Drop off (by appointment only) your prepared clothing and other items to the Lifepointe Community Center for review and placement on racks and tables beginning at 9:00 am on Fri., March 12th and ending at 4:30 pm Sun., March 14th for helpers. This should take no longer than 30 minutes if items and tags are prepared properly. We cannot accommodate early or late arrivals for drop-off.

5. Pick up unsold items on Monday, March 22nd from 10 am-1 pm. Unclaimed items will be donated to charity organizations at 1pm.

6. Enjoy the money you made turning your no-longer-needed items into CASH!
